Course Description

Clinical Neurology and Psychiatry for Psychiatrists (CNPP) is a pivotal and dynamic five-day review course. Leveraging an anonymous audience response system, CNPP employs an interactive question and answer format, enriched with didactics, to create the optimal, engaging learning experience. The course presents new and established neurology and psychiatry topics essential for the ABPN exam and attendees' clinical work. Speakers use audio, visual, and written vignettes to familiarize participants with the exam format.

Aligned closely with the content areas identified by the ABPN, the CNPP course mirrors the exam's focus. Interactive presentations, discussions, and explanations, emphasize core aspects of neurology and psychiatry. Neurological subjects include dementia from diverse illnesses, aphasia, anosognosia, other perceptual disorders, traumatic brain injury (TBI), epilepsy, antiepileptic drugs, neurotransmitters, neurological tests (CT, MRI, EEG, LP), and normal changes and illnesses associated with childhood and advanced age. Psychiatry subjects include the evaluation, diagnosis, and management of DSM psychiatric disorders across the lifespan, pharmacologic and non-pharmacologic somatic treatments, psychotherapy and other psychosocial interventions, development throughout the life cycle, legal and ethical issues, suicide, reproductive mental health, and other specialized topics.

The faculty, experienced and leaders in their fields, guide participants through the examination format, process, and test-taking strategies. Throughout the course, the faculty share valuable insights and emphasize critical, complex, or particularly significant subjects. They will not belabor the obvious or dwell on esoteric topics, ensuring a focused and pragmatic learning experience.

Educational Materials

Attendees will receive three syllabi as well as *Kaufman's Clinical Neurology for Psychiatrists* 9th edition textbook.

Educational Objectives and Expected Outcome

CNPP will prepare attendees for the new ABPN CERTIFICATION examination and offer a review of modern neurology and psychiatry. Attendees will improve their diagnostic skills, be brought up-to-date, and guided toward best practices.

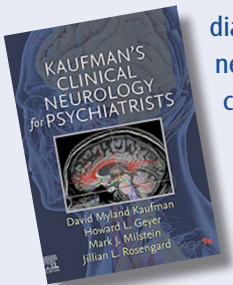
